



- Unsafe and dangerous behaviour


#### This could be in the form of:

- In serious cases, internal or external exclusion

### Attendance





- Children are encouraged to be in school daily by **no later than 8.20am** in preparation for a **8.30am** start to the school day
- Children are set an attendance target of 100% when they arrive in Year 7.
- If your child's attendance drops significantly below this figure then Tutor, Head of Year or Miss Pope (Attendance Officer) will be in contact to discuss.

### Absence Procedure



#### Child absence due to illness

 Phone through to the front office and inform the school before 9.00am that your child will be absent

#### Child absence due to medical

 If your child needs to attend a medical appointment then please inform the school via the original appointment letter, a note or phone call. Where possible make appointments outside school hours.

#### Request for leave of absence

• This can only be granted in exceptional circumstances by Mr Webber (Head Teacher)

#### □ Truancy Procedure

 If Testwood does not hear from a parent regarding a childs absence they will go onto our Truancy Procedure. A text message will be sent every hour until Testwood gets a response.
