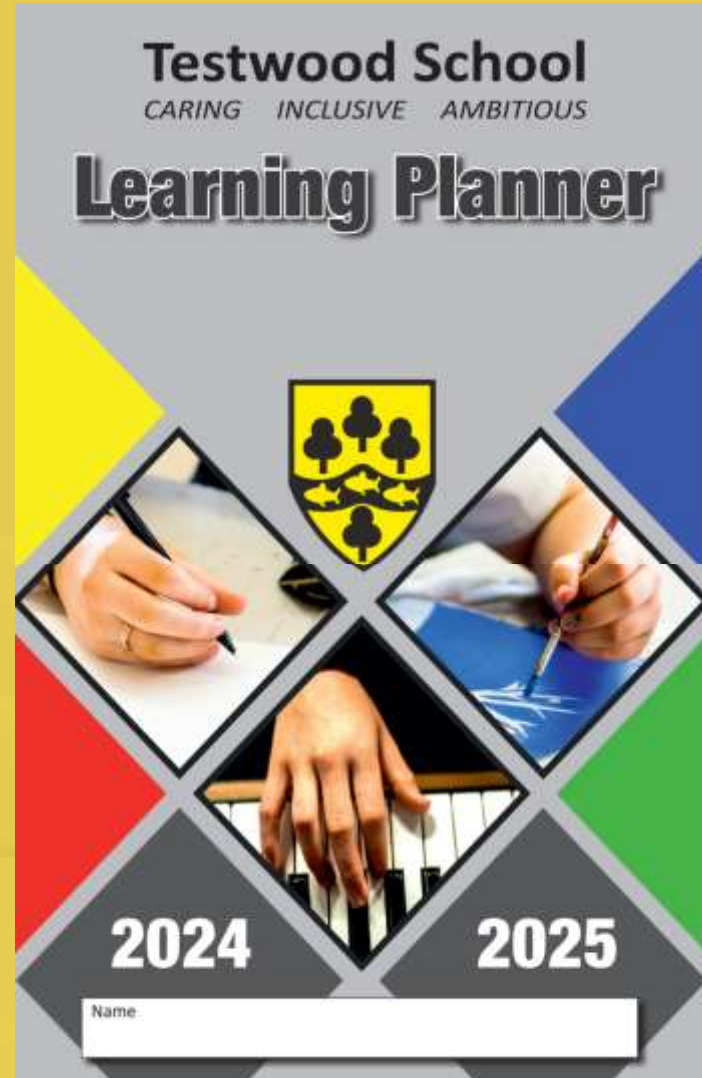

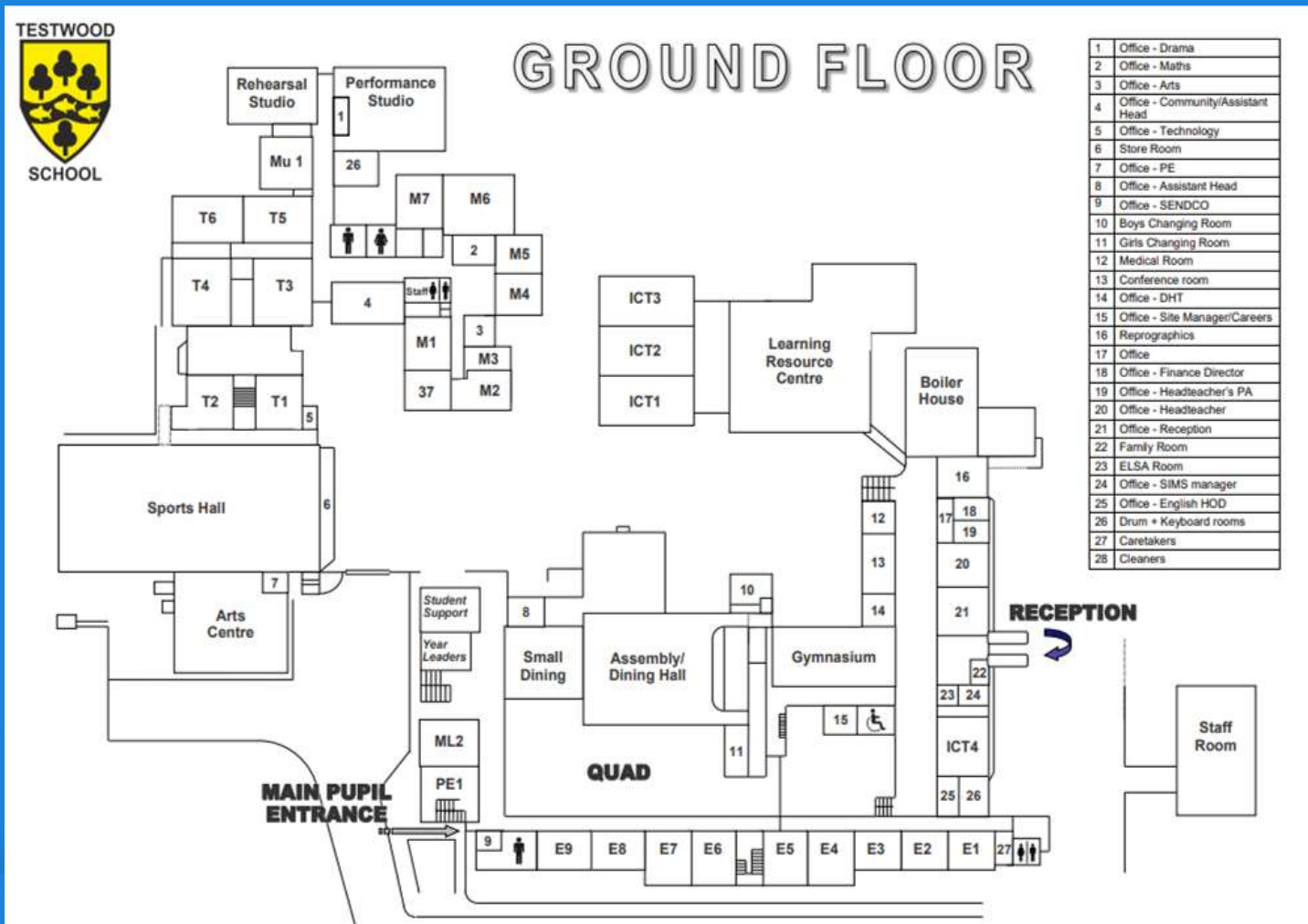

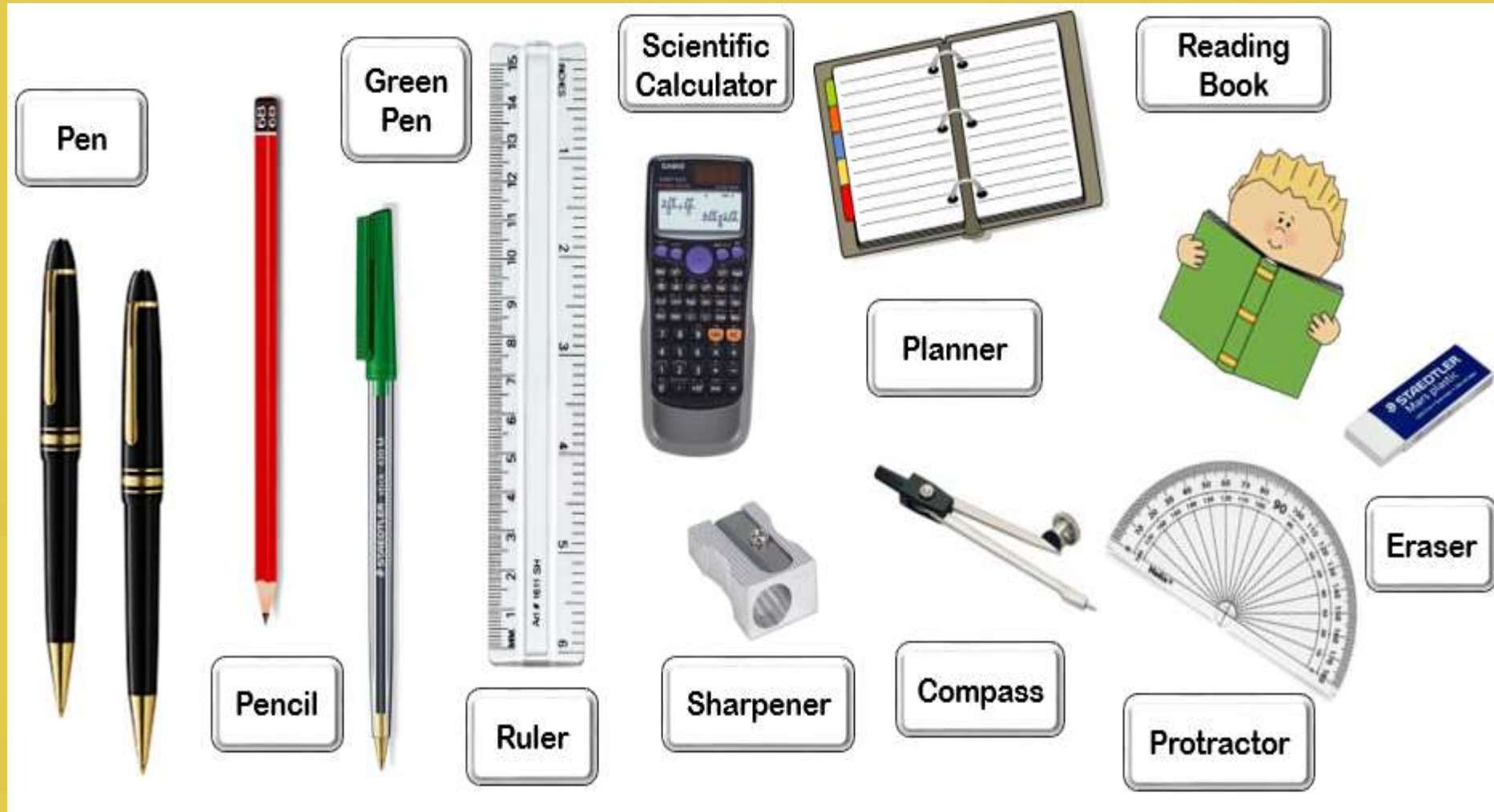

Students will receive a sanction if they are not following the school rules, which may include:


- Being late to school

- Unsafe and dangerous behaviour

This could be in the form of:

- Phone call or letter home
- After School Repair - up to 2 hours
- In serious cases, internal or external exclusion

Attendance Matters at Testwood School

At Testwood (on average)

Attendance Range	GCSE Grades Lower
89% & Below	15 GCSE grades lower
95% - 90%	5 GCSE grades lower
100% - 95%	Best grades

- ◆ Students who attend school regularly achieve higher grades than those who don't
- ◆ Excellent attendance and punctuality are important life skills
- ◆ Missing school can lead to missed opportunities

- Children are encouraged to be in school daily by **no later than 8.20am** in preparation for a **8.30am** start to the school day
- Children are set an attendance target of **100%** when they arrive in Year 7.
- If your child's attendance drops significantly below this figure then Tutor, Head of Year or Miss Pope (Attendance Officer) will be in contact to discuss.

Absence Procedure



□ Child absence due to illness

- Phone through to the front office and inform the school before 9.00am that your child will be absent

□ Child absence due to medical

- If your child needs to attend a medical appointment then please inform the school via the original appointment letter, a note or phone call. Where possible make appointments outside school hours.

□ Request for leave of absence

- This can only be granted in exceptional circumstances by Mr Webber (Head Teacher)

□ **Truancy Procedure**

- If Testwood does not hear from a parent regarding a child's absence they will go onto our Truancy Procedure. A text message will be sent every hour until Testwood gets a response.
